**Where/from whom** could you get answers to your questions or additional information? These are called **resources**.

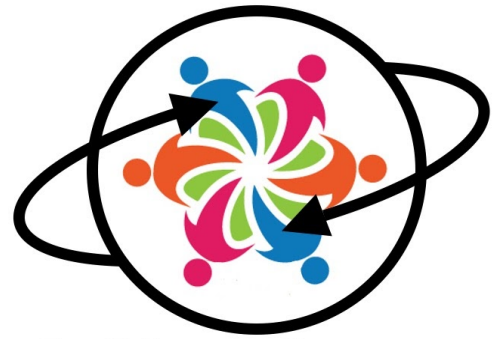
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Put a **star** next to the resources you can use **on your own** and a **checkmark** next to the ones for which you **need an adult**.
